- 5. Were Sara's misgivings about Karl believable? Do you think it was reasonable for her to overcome them and go on with the relationship?
- 6. How would you describe Karl's parents reactions to Sarah?
- 7. Was Gerhard a victim of the Nazi regime or was he a victim of his own making? Could he have avoided his fate?
